Basic requirements:


Space: Ideally as much as possible however a 5m x 7m is usually a good start if we are providing full production.

Power: A clean single phase 32A ring main supply as a minimum for the on-stage rack. We carry suitable cabling and adapters

If Stark are supplying lighting then the same will be required for this – a 32A single phase clean ring main.
